

The American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry recommends that parents of older children remain in the waiting area when children are brought into the dental exam area. Infants and some young children may benefit from having one parent in the exam area with them, but it's usually in the best interest of the child to be treated without a parent present.

## Crusader Community Health is committed to providing safe, quality dental care for your child.

We ask your cooperation in order to make the treatment of your child as safe as possible.

The policy of Crusader Community Health is one parent at a time may be allowed in the treatment area if permitted by the dentist.

For the safety and privacy of all patients, other children not being treated should remain in the reception room with a supervising adult.

There are many sharp instruments in the dental area and we do not want anyone hurt.

We are aware your comforting words or gentle touch may help your child during treatment. But we ask you to limit your verbal communication during treatment so your child can hear the care providers' discussions.

When you are near, your child may pay more attention to you rather than to the dental team.

A parent will be given a designated chair in the exam area and asked to remain there unless directed otherwise by the treating dentist.

You may be asked to leave the dental exam area at any time at the dentist's request.

With your cooperation we can make the treatment of your child as safe as possible.

Adults (18 & over) are expected to be unaccompanied in the treatment area. The only exceptions are for the presence of legal guardians and language interpreters.

Please be considerate. Mobile devices can not be used for showing or making video or audio recordings during dental visits. Cell phones should not be used during patient care. Crusader may cancel or reschedule an appointment if a patient, parent or guardian uses a mobile device during an appointment.

Pedimos de su cooperación con las siguientes normas para así mantener el orden del tratamiento de su hijo(a) durante su visita sin inconvenientes.

La póliza de Crusader Community Health es de permitir la estancia de tan solo 1 adulto junto con el paciente en el área de tratamiento si el dentista lo permite y lo cree conveniente.

Por seguridad y privacidad de todos los paciente, menores acompañantes deben permanecer en el área de espera bajo la supervisión de un adulto.

Mantenemos varios instrumentos en el área de tratamiento dental y es nuestro mayor interés proteger a nuestros pacientes de cualquier accidente.

Comprendemos que como padres, sus palabras pueden comfortar a su hijo(a) durante el tratamiento. Les pedimos por favor limitar su conversación con el paciente durante el tratamiento así su hijo(a) podrá comprender las instrucciones del dentista y ayudante.

Estando usted cerca, puede causar distracción en el paciente al momento de seguir instrucciones del dentista.

Se le asignará un lugar específico en el área de tratamiento y deberá mantenerse en esa área al menos de que el dentista requiera de su participación.

Es posible que se le pida retirarse del área de tratamiento si el dentista lo cree conveniente.

Con su cooperación podremos proveerle un tratamiento a su hijo(a) más seguro y libre de inconvenientes.

Adultos mayores de 18 años deben entrar al área de tratamiento solos (sin acompañantes) la única excepción es la presencia de un tutor legal o por la necesidad de un interprete.
